World Telecommunication Day (17 May) was marked this year at ITU headquarters by the following events:

- presentation to the ITU of new equipment for the International Amateur Radio Club;
- guided tours of the new ITU building for delegates attending the maritime conference;
- inauguration of the Union's press centre and recording studio;
- presentation of medals to Mr. Georges Valensi, one of the founders of the CCIF, and Mr. Léon Mulatier, the first elected Secretary-General of the ITU;
- presentation of certificates for 25 years of service with the Union.

■ New equipment for the International Amateur Radio Club


The International Amateur Radio Union (IARU) presented to the ITU new equipment and furniture for use by the International Amateur Radio Club (IARC) 4U1ITU, whose station is situated at ITU headquarters. A report on the presentation ceremony will be published shortly in our radio amateur column.

■ Guided tours of the ITU building

On 17 May guided tours of the new ITU building were organized for delegates attending the World Administrative Conference for Maritime Telecommunications which was held in Geneva from 22 April to 7 June 1974. Twenty-minute tours were made during the morning and afternoon breaks of the Conference and a somewhat longer tour was provided at 14.00 hours. The tour was made available in four languages, Chinese, English, French and Spanish, and the visitors were able to see some of the many gifts which have been offered to equip and decorate the extension to ITU headquarters. Each visitor was given a copy of a booklet published in 1973 to mark the inauguration of the ITU tower and a copy of the May 1973 issue of the Telecommunication Journal which included a pictorial report on the construction of the tower and a review of architecture in the service of telecommunications.

■ Inauguration of the Press Centre and Recording Studio

The new sound recording studio, a gift from the Confederation of Switzerland and the companies *Zellweger SA* and *Standard Telephon und Radio SA* was inaugurated by Mr. Fritz Locher, Director General of the Swiss PTT.
